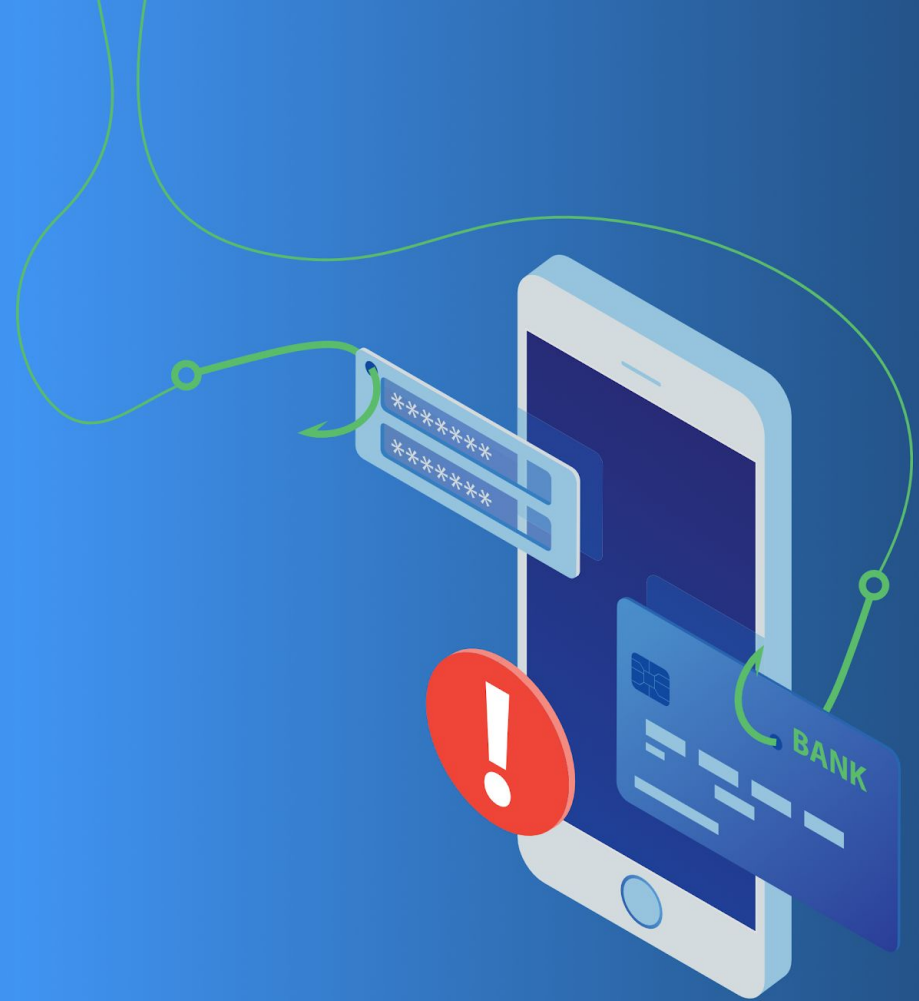
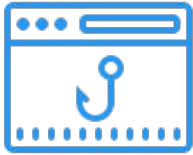

What is phishing?

Phishing is...

When someone sends an email that impersonates a trusted party (such as a bank, credit card company, insurance company) so that you give up sensitive Information.

Spear phishing is...

When someone targets a specific organization or group of users.

Email is the easiest way to deploy malware



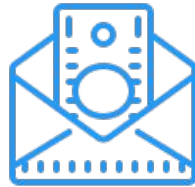

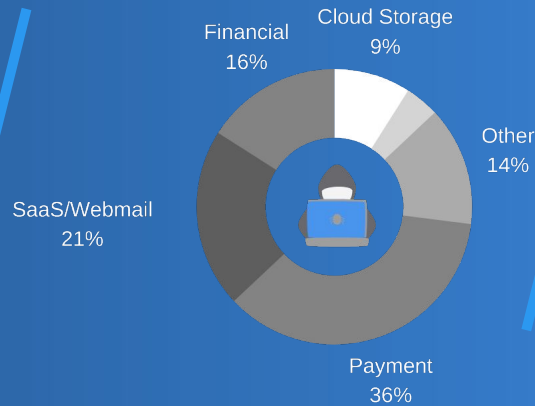

35% of Phishing Sites Use Valid SSL

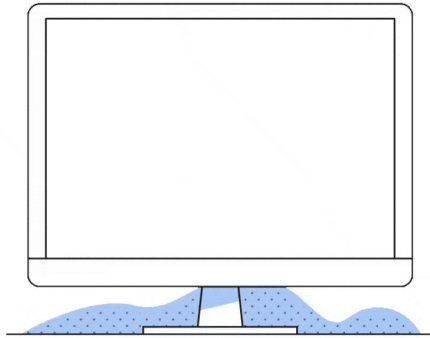

The DNSFilter agent is a lightweight endpoint agent which allows for per-device reporting and filtering. Additionally, by installing the agent you are protecting your user devices when they roam off-site, ensuring they remain protected regardless of how or where they are connecting to internet.
